INCO in H2020 vs FP7

- No ad-hoc INCO Work Programme
- No Specific Actions having the inclusion of MPCs as eligibility criteria but open topics
- Open topics
- Instruments: research & innovation actions or support actions (horizontal issues, policy, cooperation and dialogue)
- International cooperation hidden accross pillars and challenges

Methodology

Analysis of each Societal <u>challenge</u> WP for 2014 - 2015

Societal challenges

- Health, demographic change and wellbeing
- Food security, sustainable agriculture and forestry, marine and maritime and inland water research and the bioeconomy
- Secure, clean and efficient energy
- Smart, green and integrated transport
- Climate action, environment, resource efficiency and raw materials
- Inclusive, innovative and reflective societies
- Secure societies

Methodology

Aggregation into four main themes:

- 1) Health & Demographic Change
- 2) Food Security and Sustainable Agriculture
- 3) Energy, Transport, Water & Climate Change
- 4) Inclusive Societies/Science in Society

Methodology

Grouping into four cathegories:


- 1) Direct geographic relevance (Mediterranean)
- **2) Indirect geographic relevance** (ENP, Africa, S&T agreemets...)
- **3) International cooperation connotation** (no geographic focus)
- **4)Thematic relevance** (potential thematic interest for MPCs)


70 topics in total have been identified, according to the four thematic areas and to the four categories of relevance.

Focus on the 4 themes



Out of 70 topics, 12 have a focus on health, 12 on inclusive societies, 17 on food security and sustainable agriculture, 29 on Energy, Transport, Water & Climate Change (the last grouping more societal challenges).

Focus on the four categories of relevance



Out of 70 topics, 3 have direct Mediterranean relevance, 8 have Indirect geographic relevance, 34 have an international cooperation connotation, 25 have thematic relevance.

Conclusions (1/2)

- Mediterranean dimension is rather limited (3 topics)
- Good presence of topics addressing Mediterranean countries in association with other countries/regions (8 topics, ranging from research infrastructure, NCPs, small farms, climate change...)
- Important presence of topics encouraging international cooperation These topics are open to all countries and are of potential interest for the Mediterranean since they address relevant themes (innovation, natural resources, health, agrofood, energy, transport, climate change, sustainable development).

Conclusions (2/2)

- Good number of topics with no reference to international cooperation nor to the Mediterranean but with a high thematic relevance
- All topics identified mainly belong to two types of actions:
 Coordination and Support Actions and Research and Innovation Actions.
- Wide range of topics (other than the ones addressing only the <u>Mediterranean</u>) offering **good opportunities** for research actors of this region – either in thematic issues or cross-cutting activities.
